I am writing to invite you to participate in the "**Educators GIS Workshop**", hosted by Chinese International School (CIS) Humanities Department, Hong Kong. This will be the third GIS workshop hosted by CIS, building on its earlier success in 2004 & 2006 where Geographical Information Systems was introduced to 30 International teachers from the Asian region.

This 3rd. workshop is for International School based teachers who have begun to use Geotechnologies within their curriculum, using Arcview 9.1 and would like to further develop their use. As you would know, Geographical Information System (GIS) can be incorporated into your current Geography, ICT or Science program, building on student's spatial data literacy or as a complete new unit of study, with GIS as the focus. CIS students, aged 11 to 18 have been using GIS in their **International Baccalaureate's Middle Years Program and Diploma Program** Geography courses for over 9 years.

The workshop will be co-presented by the internationally known Geotechnology educator, Mr. Mark Lowry and Mr. David Brian, a Hong Kong based Geography teacher.

Highlights of the program are:

- Intermediate to advance use of Geotechnology using the ARCGIS platform (ArcView 9.1)
- Using Arc-catalogue
- Experimenting with the new extensions including:
 - 3D analyst
 - Spatial analyst
- Field Data sampling incorporating the use of GPS
- Web based integration with ARCGIS

If you would like introduce Geotechnology into your program or build on your existing use of it, then this workshop will be suited for you.
