## Sir Cecil's Ride

**Ending Point:** Tai Tam Road

**District:** Hong Kong Island

**Duration:** 4.5 hours

Level of difficulty: 2 out of 5

## The Neighbourhoods

Braemar Hill is located in the northeast of Hong Kong Island. It is mainly a residential and school area. It is very accessible and can be reached by buses and taxis. Tai Tam is a quiet, green peninsula and is located in the southeast of Hong Kong Island and it has stunning views of the sea.

Sir Cecil's Ride is a route, which mainly consists of smooth paths along the hillsides. It begins at Braemar Hill Road and heads southwards, all the way to Tai Tam Road. On this enjoyable walking trail you can experience the green and peaceful side of Hong Kong. Various interesting plants and insects can be found along the path and the placid Tai Tam reservoir (pictured above) offers stark contrast to the bustling city life of Hong Kong. So just relax and enjoy nature.

## Public Transportation

Location	Bus no.
Central to Braemar Hill	25
North Point to Braemar Hill	27

Using the MTR is also another option. The nearest MTR station to Braemar Hill is in North Point, so you could take the MTR to North Point and the 27 bus to Braemar Hill.

Location	Bus no.
Tai Tam to Chai Wan	314
Tai Tam to Central	309

The nearest MTR station to Tai Tam is in Chai Wan, so you could take the 314 bus to Chai Wan and then the MTR to your next destination.
