The Lookout

Throughout the day the lookout is usually peaceful and quite. It is located on the top a mountain around the Braemar Hill area. It is a great place for people to rest and relax. Around this lookout there are a few unique features such a compass to show all Hong Kong landmarks directions. Also there are paths which are made of pebbles. These pebbles are specially shaped to massage your feet and it targets all the pressure points throughout the body.

Neighborhood

Braemar Hill is situated in the north side of Hong Kong in the North Point district. There are various ways to reach Braemar hill, the best mode of transport being public bus. There are around 3 buses that all go straight to the bus terminus. Information on the three buses is shown below.

Location	Bus Type/ Number Travel Time*
Central- IFC II and Hong Kong Ferry Pier	First Bus/ 25C- 40 minutes
Causeway Bay- Patterson Street, near Pearl City Shopping Mall	Yellow/Green Mini Bus 25- 15 minutes
Tin Hau- MTR station, bus terminus	Yellow/Green Mini Bus 49M- 10-15 minutes

*Travel Time will differ, depending on traffic conditions

Directions

To get to the lookout, starting from the bus terminus you will need to walk east passing the Saint Joan of Arc school and carry on for around 3 km (ignoring any junctions), there will be stairs go up and follow them to the top. Upon arrival you will see benches and a compass.
