Travelers' Code of Ethics:

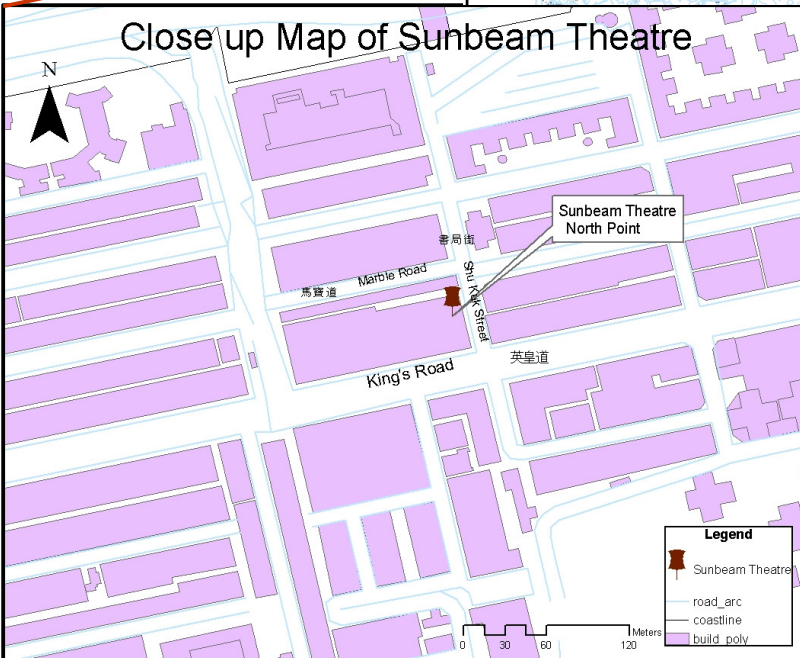
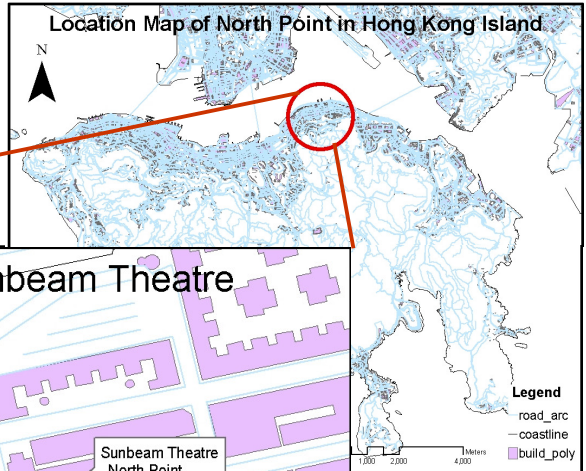
- Do not litter while watching these Chinese performances!
