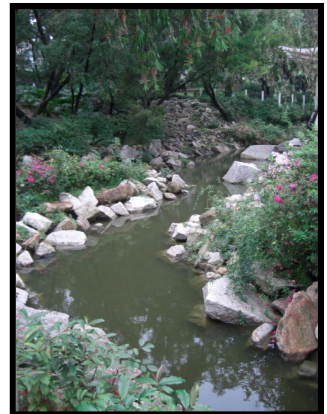

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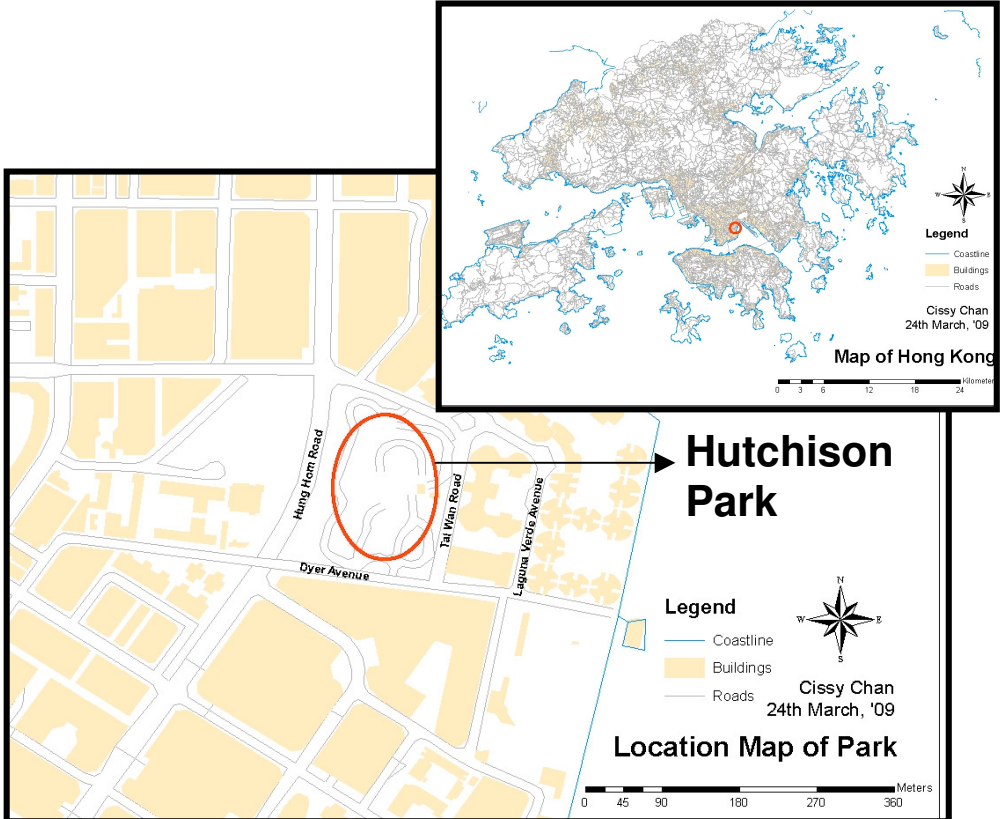
What can possible be better than taking a walk in an area decorated solely by nature's own assortment of colors after a long, busy day?
