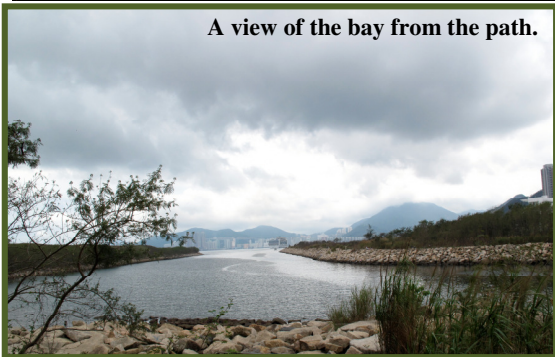

## 灣 畔 徑 Wan Poon Path

Few who visit Hong Kong would have visited Wan Poon Path, a short path in Tseung Kwan O that overlooks Junk Bay. Despite the unpleasant naming of the bay, the path takes visitors on a walk with a breathtaking view of the beautiful bay and Hong Kong Island.

The path circles around the border of the bay, and actually cuts into a small hill, creating jagged sections of rocks that reach towards the bay. You'll love the way you can climb down to the shore of the bay, sit on the rocks and try your luck at fishing or explore the small caves. You can even take a small boat out to enjoy the view or go fishing! (Word of warning: Make sure you can swim!) Along the path are also benches where you can take a rest and enjoy the view, boats in which you can buy a few freshly caught fishes, and more fishing spots, all right in front of a spectacular bay.

### The Neighborhood

Wan Poon Path is located in Tseung Kwan O, a part of the Sai Kung District in New Territories. It starts at a secluded entrance right in front of the private estate Oscar by the Sea (see map), and crosses the bay, where it then splits into several paths that reaches into the center of Tseung Kwan O.

### The Walk

**Distance:** 1 km

**Difficulty:** 1/5 (quite a few steps going up and down, but mainly just flat pavement)

**Estimated time:** 20 minutes

### How to get there?

**By MTR:** Get off at **Hang Hau Station, Exit A**, then take the **109M Green Minibus**. Get off at **Oscar by the Sea**, which is the last stop. (Refer to map to see route to the path)

**Estimated time:** From Hang Hau to entrance of path, **15 minutes**.



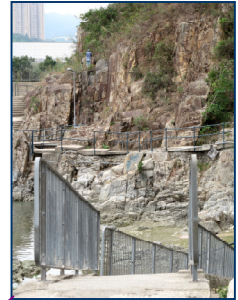
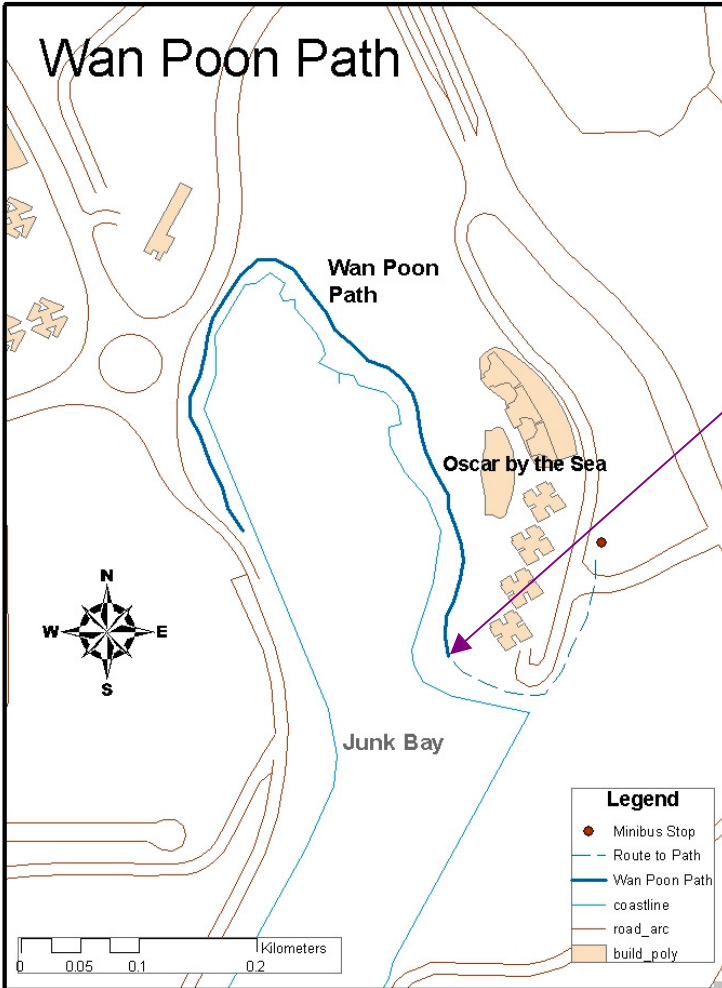

Leave no litter, and pick up litter left by others.



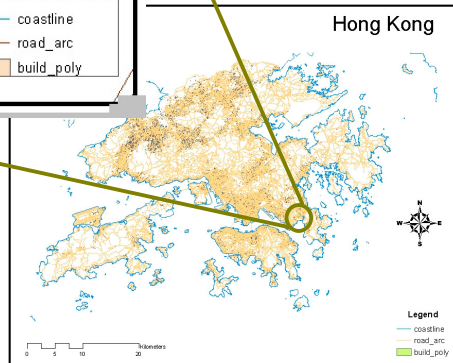
