The ONLY revolving restaurant in Hong Kong -- R66

Have you ever thought of having lunch/dinner in a revolving restaurant, locating on the 62nd floor of a cylindrical building? What if I tell you the quality of the pictures you take in here (of Victoria Harbour) would be the same as you take them on the Peak? This is all about R66 restaurant. The restaurant got this name because it takes a total of 66 minutes for one rotation. That means, all you have to do in this restaurant is to enjoy the food, and only take pictures when the view comes to you.

The environment

Due to the circular shape of the restaurant, it has a unique sitting arrangement. The tables are located in 3 levels. The first level is closest to the slanted floor-to-ceiling windows; it allows the customers to observe tiny humans and vehicle 62 floors below. Behind that is the second level, and 4 steps above that is the third level. These levels allow customers to see further. If you want to see the Victoria Harbour, sit on the third level! The tables on the upper levels all face toward the windows, and they are in the shape of semi-circles. You will get to sit closer with your friends, while enjoying the panoramic scenery of Central, Wan Chai and Happy Valley!

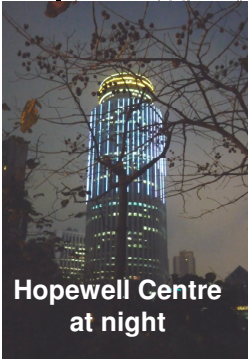

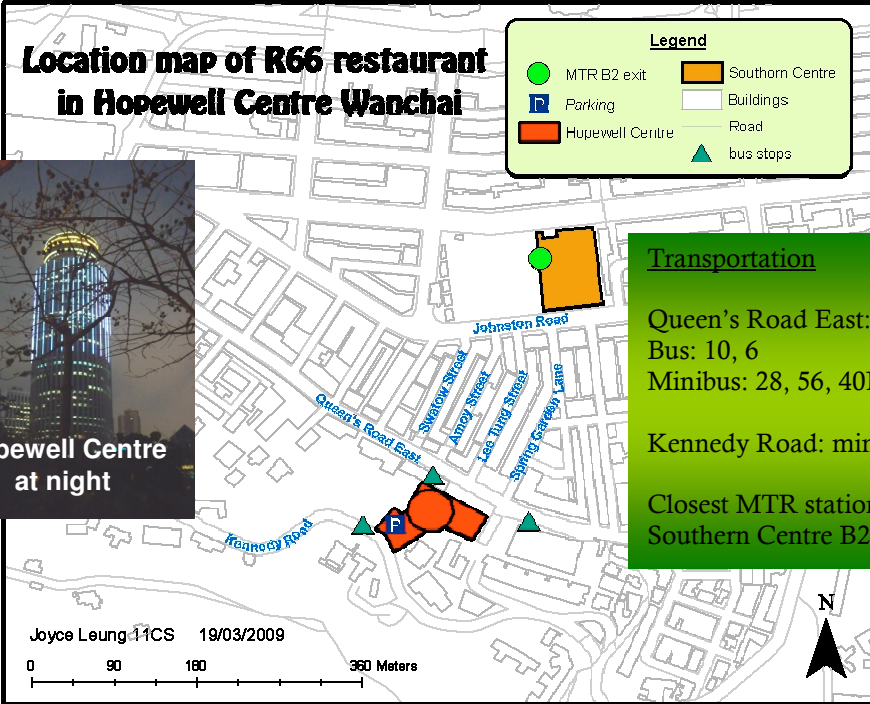
Location map of R66 restaurant in Hopewell Centre Wanchai

Travellers Code of Ethics

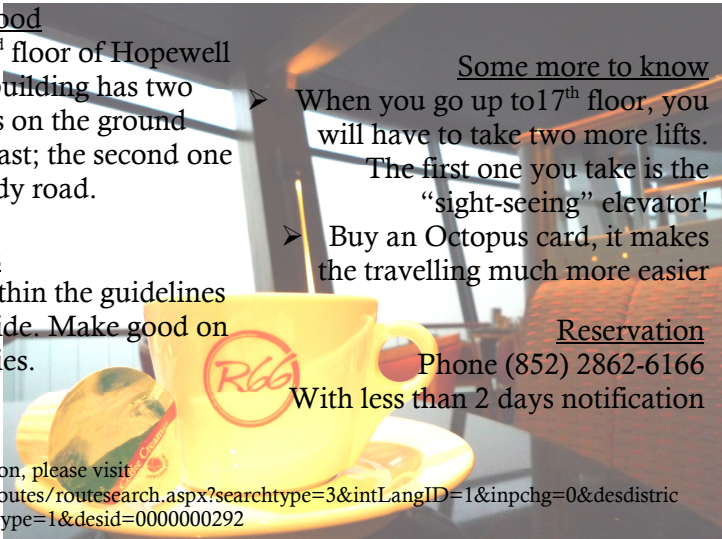
- Take photographs within the guidelines suggested by your guide. Make good on promises to send copies.
