The Clementi Path

Jardine's Lookout is one of Hong Kong's most serene, verdurous and calm neighbourhood. It nestles right in between Happy Valley and the south side of the Island. Jardine's Lookout is famous for older style low-rise apartment blocks or townhouses, and also some beautiful detached properties.

The Clementi Path

The path was named after Sir Cecil Clementi (1875 - 1947) who was the governor of Hong Kong. As time pass, little does the people know that this path has been there for more than a decade.

The walk is about fifteen minutes long. At the end is a small park and playground where you can sit and relax.
