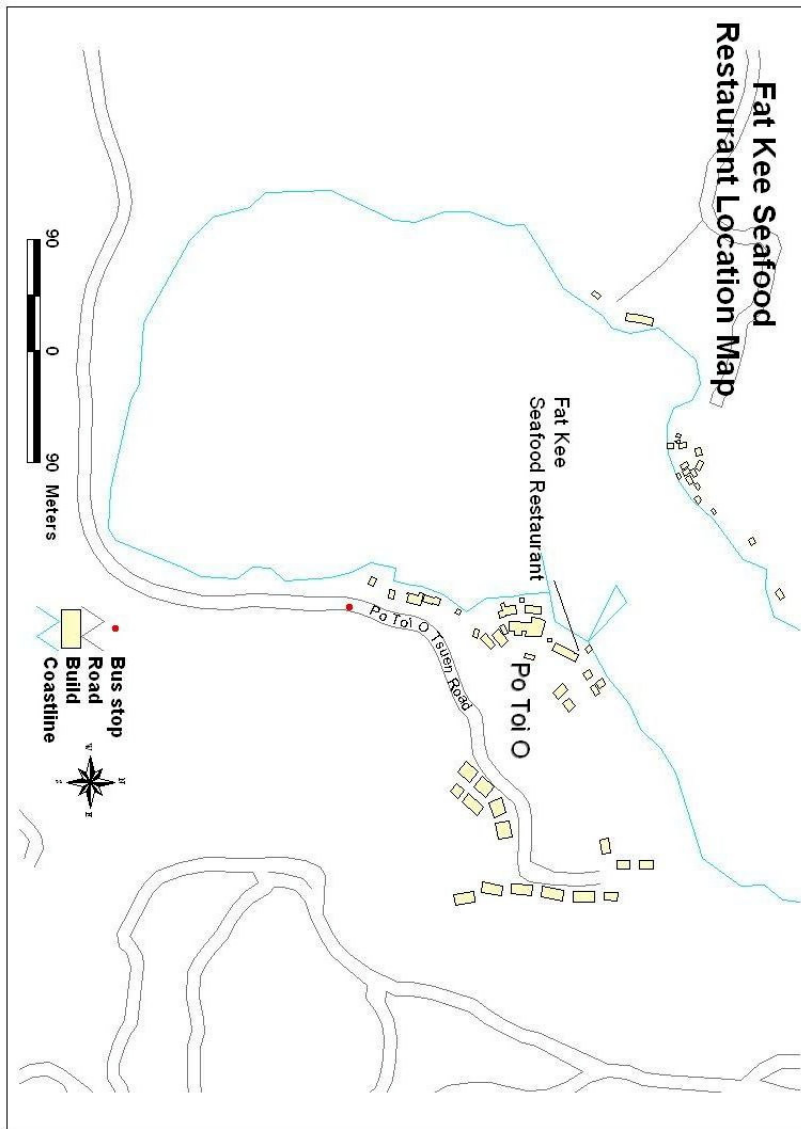

# Food Culture

## Fat Kee Seafood Restaurant Po Toi O, Clear Water Bay



Po Toi O is one of the very few villages in Hong Kong with a seafood farm. So visiting the Fat Kee Seafood Restaurant is always a good opportunity to get a good meal of fresh seafood. Visitors may first visit the seafood farms and pick out their meal straight from there, and then enjoy the seafood meal by the pier starting out into Clear Water Bay. Surrounding the restaurant are small stalls with dry seafood, often there are not only dried seafood for sale but the seafood being dried are in the view as well.

### Neighbourhood

Po Toi O is at the end of the little Po Toi O Tsuen Road is at the end of the Clear Water Bay Road, which is at the border of Sai Kung district by Tseung Kwan O in the south. Most of the Clear

Water Bay road is made of residential complexes as it is famous for its good sea views. To get to the end of this road to reach the little Po Toi O Tsuen Road, one can take the follow transportation.

Starting bus stop	Bus no.	Destination
Po Lam	16	Po Toi O

After getting of at the Po Toi O bus terminus, all visitors need to do is walk along the single path by the bay (the path which is closer to the labeled restaurant, as seen on the map) till you reach the end, where the Fat Kee Seafood restaurant will be.
