

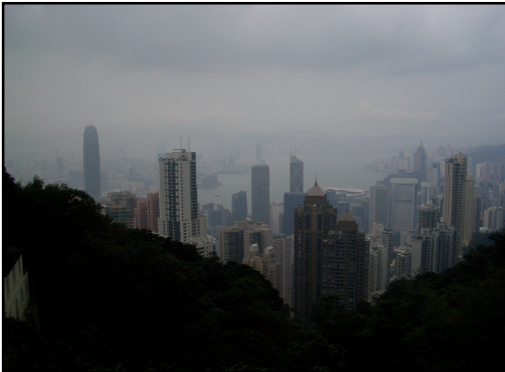

Victoria Harbor Photo Point Old Peak Road Trail

Due to the unfamiliar location of Old Peak Road Trail, most of the people are unaware of the existence of this trail. However, the Old Peak Road Trail has the perfect location for taking urban scenery photographs not only of Victoria Harbor, but also Central, Admiralty and Wanchai. It is located just below the Peak Gallery.

The location has a very cool and calm atmosphere, and after relaxing at the scene, you may want to walk up to the Peak, and enjoy excellent cuisine, shopping and maybe even take a ride on the renowned Peak Tram.

Neighborhood

Old Peak Road is located in the Central (Mid Levels) District, Hong Kong Island. It can be

reached by a variety of mini buses, which either pass through Old Peak Road or Tregunter Path. Three bus routes are suggested below, with each of the buses either using Octopus Cards or loose change.

Getting to the Photo Point Location

If you are up for a steep climb, then you should take Mini Bus 2, because it stops close to the trail (Tregunter South Entrance). You then walk Westerly for about 3 minutes, and to your left is the trail. You climb up for about 20 minutes, and you will approach a forked trail, and some housing buildings. Turn right, and keep walking for about 200m, and climb up the stairs. To your left will be a spot where you can take a picture of Victoria Harbor (as seen to your left). However, you can also take the Peak Tram from Kennedy Road, and walk about 100m west, pass the Peak Gallery and turn right, and you will end up at the Photo point.
